**Local Law No. 3 of the year 2016**

**A Local Law to Terminate the Coordinated Assessment Program between the Town of Clayton and the Town of Cape Vincent, New York Upon the Conclusion of the 2016 Roll and as of the Commencement of the 2017 Roll.**

**Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Clayton as follows:**

Section 1.

The Towns of Clayton and Cape Vincent utilized a shared assessor pursuant to the Towns' Coordinated Assessment Program, which was created by an Intermunicipal Coordinated Assessment Agreement made the 9th day of January, 2014, and amended by a Supplemental Intermunicipal Agreement made the 20th day of February, 2014.

By mutual agreement of the Towns of Clayton and Cape Vincent, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Clayton hereby terminates the Coordinated Assessment Program upon the conclusion of the 2016 roll and as of the start of the 2017 roll.

Section 2.

This local law is adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Clayton pursuant to the following authorities:

- a. Subdivision 4(c) of Section 579 of the New York Real Property Tax Law, which expressly authorizes a local government to terminate a coordinated assessment program by the adoption of a local law adopted by at least 50% of the participating assessing units, and
- b. Paragraph "14" of the Inter-Municipal Coordinated Assessment Agreement between the Town of Clayton and the Town of Cape Vincent, dated January 9, 2014, which expressly authorizes withdrawal from the Agreement by adoption of a local law passed by a majority vote of the Town Board.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall take effect upon the filing with the Secretary of State as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
