Status of Pending Litigation(s):

There is no pending General Litigation.

Assessment Litigation:

There is one property left in the multiple parcel tax assessment case. All but one of the petitioners settled, and the one that did not is still pending before the Supreme Court. There has been no movement on that case since the rest of them settled, and our plan is to sit tight until the petitioner makes a move or the court requires us to do something.
