



Joint Town and Village of Clayton Comprehensive Land Use Plan Update 2015

The Town and Village of Clayton is beginning the job of updating its Joint Comprehensive Land Use Plan from 1998. A Comprehensive Plan is a document that describes the history, current state, and future vision for the community. It acts as a road map to guide future growth and development while promoting the health, safety and general welfare of the people.

A duly appointed committee is overseeing this process and hopes to submit a draft of the revised Comprehensive Plan to the Town and Village Boards by 2016. **The Committee would like to know what type of development the residents would like and where this development should occur, and so a survey was developed.**

Completing the survey the Committee developed is one of the ways to allow residents the opportunity to provide input into the process. Several questions will be area-specific while others will be more general in addressing a variety of topics usually associated with future community planning.

The Comprehensive Plan should reflect the ideas and opinions of the community's residents. EVERY Clayton resident and/or property owner is invited to complete this survey. Each person may submit the survey once. Your survey responses will be kept confidential.
