Kate Wehrle, Depauville Library, presented to the Town Board to update on the past several months. The Summer Tutoring Program has sponsored 229 sessions for youths within the community. They have been working with Northern New York Community Foundation with regards to grants, currently have been offered a \$4,000.00 matching grant and a \$5,000.00 endowment, this already has a match of \$1,000.00 for this year. They are looking for insight with regards to the greenhouse that came down last fall with the windstorm. Currently, the library is providing curbside services and computer use and printing by appointment. Staff stressed the importance of the 2020 Census. Tresa Forkey spoke to the tutoring program as well.
